# 3 PHASES FOR A SMOOTH TRANSITION

Introducing the NEW Continuing Certification Program. We asked. You answered.

The ABPM Board and Staff have developed a NEW CCP that was conceived with feedback from our Diplomates. The program is simple, relevant, innovative, and created in compliance with the new ABMS standards for Continuing Certification. For more information, check out ABMS' Board Certification Standards.

To ensure a smooth transition, the NEW ABPM CCP will be rolled out in 3 phases:

**PHASE 1:** January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2024

**PHASE 2:** January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2029

**PHASE 3:** January 1, 2030, to December 31, 2039
