

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

All ABPM Specialties & Subspecialties: Initial Certifications, 2014-2023




Specialty Certificates as Proportion of All Specialty Certificates



ABPM Network

American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS)

- A federation of 24 Member Boards including ABPM
- ABPM works collaboratively with the other 23 Member Boards to set joint policy and operational standards.
- ABPM is a separate and independent organization in the conduct of its business and chooses to cooperate within the federation.
- ABPM is obligated to comply with action items/standards determined by the ABMS Board of Directors
 - Continuing Certification Standards

Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)

- Preventive Medicine Review Committee (RC)
 - Specific to preventive medicine residencies
 - Sets the standards of accreditation for preventive medicine within the global ACGME accreditation standards
- Relationship with ABPM
 - ABPM provides candidates for RC member positions in each of the Specialty areas
 - ABPM's Executive Director is an ex-officio member of the RC
 - ABPM worked with ACGME on:
 - The Milestones Project
 - Exceptionally Qualified International Medical Graduate designation

- Specialties:
 - Aerospace Medical Association (AsMA)
 - American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine (ACOEM)
 - American College of Preventive Medicine (ACPM)
- Subspecialties:
 - American Medical Informatics Association (AMIA)

 - Undersea and Hyperbaric Medical Society (UHMS)

Program Directors

- Vital link between ABPM and next generation of Preventive Medicine physicians
 - First significant contact Residents/Fellows have with ABPM Diplomates
 - Communicate value of ABPM Certification and encourage Residents/Fellows to become Certified
 - Provide valuable information to ABPM via surveys, summits and other communication
- ABPM & Program Directors work together to advance the cause of Preventive Medicine Specialties & Subspecialties
 - PDs make up large proportion of item-writing subcommittee members
 - As ABPM Board members and/or Sub-board Chairs, PDs influence Board priorities and bring important experience and expertise to Board discussions


Certification Exam Update

Alternative Residency/Fellowship Pathways

Combined Training Programs (CTPs)

- CTPs are residency programs that meet the program requirements of both a Preventive Medicine Specialty AND another ABMS Member Board's Specialty.
 - CTPs must be approved by both ABPM and the other ABMS Member Board prior to accepting trainees

Integrated Training Experiences (ITEs)

- ITEs allow an individual physician to shorten their training time in two different ACGME-accredited fellowship programs.
 - ITEs must meet all program requirements for the ABPM fellowship program
 - ITE physician candidates must have current ABMS Member Board Certification
 - ITE physician candidates must meet all other ABPM eligibility criteria
 - Fellowship programs must obtain approval from ABPM for each ITE physician candidate

Submitting an Application

- Access the application through the ABPM website: <u>www.theabpm.org</u>
- In the "Become Certified" section, choose the appropriate specialty/subspecialty and pathway and click "Apply Now"
- Details provided in ABPM's Program Director Guidebook

ACGME-Accredited Fellowship Pathway

Requires successful completion of a minimum of 12 months in an ACGME-accredited Addiction Medicine fellowship program. If the program is longer than 12 months, the physician must successfully complete all years of training for which the program is accredited in order to meet the eligibility criteria for certification.

- Fellowship: Completion of a fellowship of at least 12 months that is acceptable to the ABPM in the subspecialty for which certification is being sought.
- S Current ABMS Board Certification.

OR AOA board certification or Canadian Board Certification (RCPSC or CFPC) will be recognized as an acceptable primary certificate for physicians seeking subspecialty certification in Addiction Medicine from ABPM.

To be eligible to take the ABPM subspecialty certification examinations, AOA-board certified and Canadian-board (RCPSC or CFPC) certified physicians must successfully complete an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) accredited fellowship in the relevant subspecialty, as well as meet all other current ABPM requirements for that subspecialty.

- Medical License Verification (ABPM will confirm after application)
- Soard Certification Verification (ABPM will confirm after application)
- Fellowship Verification
- 1 Letter of Reference from a physician who is certified by the ABMS, if 24 months past

Continuing Certification Program – Three-Phase Plan

Three-Phase Implementation of CCP

- Phase 1 January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2024
- Phase 2 January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2029
- Phase 3 January 1, 2030, to December 31, 2039

Phase 1 Requirements

January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2024

Review of Professional Standing

At all times, ABPM Diplomates shall be required to maintain a <u>full, valid, and unrestricted license to practice medicine</u> in all states, territories or jurisdictions for which the Diplomate has a license to practice medicine.

Lifelong Professional Development

- 20 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits[™] between January 1, 2023, and December 31, 2023
 - 6 of the 20 CME Credits must be specific to the Diplomate's ABPM Certification(s)
- 20 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits[™] between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2024
 - 6 of the 20 CME Credits must be specific to the Diplomate's ABPM Certification(s)
- Diplomates shall attest annually to completion of the CME requirement via the online "Attestation Form" on the ABPM Physician Portal.
- No audits will be conducted during Phase 1

ABPM Annual Fee

• Pay the Annual Fee using the ABPM Physician Portal by December 31.

Phase 2 Requirements

January 1, 2025, to December 31, 2029

Review of Professional Standing

At all times, ABPM Diplomates shall be required to maintain a <u>full, valid, and unrestricted license to practice medicine</u> in all states, territories or jurisdictions for which the Diplomate has a license to practice medicine.

Lifelong Professional Development

- 20 *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits*[™] annually regardless of the number of ABPM Certificates.
 - 6 of the 20 CME credits must be specific to a Diplomate's ABPM Certification(s).
- Diplomates shall attest annually to completion of the CME requirement via the online "Attestation Form" on the ABPM Physician Portal.
- ABPM shall audit up to 5% of attestations for compliance.
 - Audits demonstrating non-compliance will result in Suspension of Diplomate's ABPM Certification(s).
 - Diplomate shall have a period of six-months to complete the "missed" CME requirement.
 - Diplomates who timely complete "missed" CMEs will be subject to automatic audit for the next 2 calendar years.
 - If a Diplomate has not completed the "missed" CME requirement in the six-month period, that Diplomate's Certification(s) shall be Revoked and the Diplomate will be subject to re-entry requirements.

LAP Transition Plan (Jan 1, 2025-Dec 31, 2029)

- All Time-Limited Diplomates shall be required to participate in the LAP.
- Answer 30 Specialty/Subspecialty questions annually
 - <u>Diplomate with Multiple ABPM Certifications MUST participate in LAP for each</u> <u>Certificate</u>
- Open-book: reference materials may be consulted
- There will be no time limit for a Diplomate's response to an individual LAP item
 - Once a Diplomate "opens an item" the Diplomate must answer and cannot close the item (by closing the browser window) prior to submitting a response. Doing so will result in the response being marked incorrect.
- The extended LAP Pilot will be subject to industry-standard psychometric analysis for longitudinal assessment platforms. Each year the ABPM will determine a minimum passing score (MPS); Diplomates who achieve the MPS will pass that year's LAP.
- Diplomates who fail to meet the MPS in 4 of the 5 administrations during Phase 2 shall be required to participate in a Remediation Activity.

ABPM Annual Fee

• Pay the Annual Fee using the ABPM Physician Portal by December 31.

Phase 3 Requirements

January 1, 2030, to December 31, 2039

CCP Requirements in Phase 3

- Pay administrative fee Annual
- Maintain full, valid/unrestricted medical license Annual
- Complete 20 AMA PRA Category 1 Credits[™] Annual
- Participate in LAP by answering 30 questions (untimed & openbook) – Annual
- Complete one Improvement in Health & Health Care (IHHC) activity designed to positively impact & improve a Diplomate's practice – Once every 5 years
 - Specifics of the IHHC requirement subject to ABMS 3C approval
