


### **New ABPM Certifications, 2014-2024**



Specialty Certificates as a Proportion of all Specialty Certificates\*





Subspecialty Certificates as a Proportion of All Subspecialty Certificates\*




Specialty/Subspecialty Certificates as a Proportion of All Certificates\*

- + 35% of Time-Limited Certificates are in a Specialty.


# Diplomate Age by Specialty/Subspecialty\*



# Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)





### + Preventive Medicine Review Committee (RC)

- Specific to preventive medicine residencies
- Sets accreditation standards for preventive medicine within global ACGME accreditation standards

### + Relationship with ABPM

- ABPM nominates candidates for RC membership in each specialty
- ABPM's CEO is an ex-officio RC member
- ABPM worked with ACGME on:
  - The Milestones Project
  - Exceptionally Qualified International Medical Graduate designation


# + Vital link between ABPM and next generation of preventive medicine physicians








# **ABPM Exam Registrations, 2014-2023**








# Specialty Exam Pass Rates, 2005-2023











# Training in Multiple Specialties/Subspecialties



- + Two options for physicians to train in and become eligible for certification in an ABPM specialty/subspecialty and another ABMS specialty/subspecialty
  - Combined Programs
  - Integrated Training Experiences
- + ITEs allow a physician to use research/electives from one training program to "jumpstart" into another program
- + Combined Programs reduce overall training time by eliminating duplicate educational components
- + Unique requirements apply to each option



### ABPM ITE AND COMBINED PROGRAM GUIDE

Having trouble deciding if your experience fits into an ITE or Combined Program?

Use the chart below to help you determine the appropriate path forward.

#### Integrated Training Experience

- Uses research or electives from one program to "jumpstart" into another program.
- The ABPM-sponsored Specialty or Subspecialty cannot be truncated or otherwise shortened.
- Programs must seek approval for each individual physician.
- ABPM requires annual review to monitor applicant status.
  - Rotations in the ABPM-sponsored Specialty or Subspecialty cannot differ from those in the ACGMEaccredited program.

Programs must be ACGMEaccredited.

Programs must request approval at least 60 days prior to the expected ABPM start date.

> Programs must submit a letter of approval from the other ABMS Board being included.

# Combined Program

- Some curriculum overlaps between the two Specialties and/or Subspecialties.
  - Reduces training time by eliminating duplicate educational components.
  - ABPM reviews Combined Programs as a whole.
  - ABPM requires engagement every five years to monitor the use of the Combined Program, status of exam take rates, and exam results.
- Approved programs can continue accepting new learners, so long as there are no major revisions to the approved program structure.

- + Access the application through the ABPM website: www.theabpm.org
- + In the "Become Certified" section, choose the appropriate specialty/subspecialty, then the pathway. Click "Apply Now."
- + You will be directed to ABPM's application platform

#### **Documents and Verifications**

- CV/Resume, if 24 months past fellowship completion date
- Medical License Verification (ABPM will confirm after application)
- Doard Certification Verification (ABPM will confirm after application)
- Fellowship Verification
- 1 Letter of Reference from a physician who is certified by the ABMS, if 24 months past fellowship completion date
